Student Scholarships

Hershey Theatre Apollo Awards Scholarships

Every year, the Hershey Theatre Apollo Awards presents scholarship funds to each student nominated for an award. This feature is one of the unique aspects of this awards program. Each student receives a \$250 scholarship per HTAA nomination received, and each school receives \$100 per nomination for its theater arts program.

Dickinson College – John Montgomery Scholarship

Dickinson College recognizes any academically competitive high school junior nominee who is admitted to Dickinson during his/her senior year with the John Montgomery Scholarship. The John Montgomery Scholarship is worth \$40,000 of tuition support for eight semesters of full-time study at the college.

Harry and Lorraine Ausprich Endowment Scholarship for the Arts

The Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education Foundation offers the Harry and Lorraine Ausprich Endowment Scholarship for the Arts. The \$500 scholarship is presented to an award recipient who is currently a senior in high school and will be attending one of the 14 Pennsylvania state universities in the fall.

Lancaster Bible College Scholarship

Lancaster Bible College recognizes any academically competitive high school junior or senior who is admitted into the Musical Theatre Program or as a Live Production Major with a \$10,000 scholarship (\$2500 renewable annually over four years.) This scholarship will be awarded to any academically competitive Hershey Theatre Apollo Awards nominee or Spirit of Theater Award recipient.

Student Opportunities

NYC Experience

The recipients of Outstanding Lead Actor/Actress in a Play and Musical will join Co-Executive Directors of the Apollo program on a unique three (3) day trip to New York in June. The students will have the opportunity to:

- Meet professional currently working on Broadway and participate in Q&A sessions
- Attend at least one Master Class conducted by a professional to develop skills and receive feedback on their performances
- Attend a least one (1) Broadway and one (1) off-Broadway show with possible post show tours and Q&A
- Tour Radio City Music Hall and Barclay Center in Brooklyn

Open Stage of Harrisburg

Open Stage of Harrisburg offers each student nominee a \$100 scholarship to a summer workshop. Outstanding Supporting Actor and Actress in both play and musical categories receive a full scholarship to attend the 2017 summer musical theater workshop. www.openstagehbg.com
